
> INTRODUCTION

Since its first edition, the National League of Challenges in Cyberspace, also known as National CyberLeague (NCL), has intended to be an innovative initiative, mainly aimed at spreading the culture of safety, through the enhancement of talent of our young people on cybersecurity. All with the crucial aim of promoting their employability and helping them achieve a better future without the need for expatriate.

In this third edition, it is also committed to consolidate this innovative project as a meeting point for the main actors (public and private) in the field of cybersecurity, not only nationally but also internationally.

In accordance with this, another professional test between teams belonging to different Spanish and foreign police forces will be held in parallel to the cybercompetition among students.

The Guardia Civil, aligned with the main actors in cybersecurity, especially INCIBE, is fully committed to supporting the full incorporation of our young people into the complex process of technological change that we are experiencing, while, as a security body, we aspire to ensure “order and law” in cyberspace.

Through this initiative, the Guardia Civil tries to be the link between our young people and public and private organizations, to promote and attract their talent through a fun, but demanding, competition.




> WHAT DOES IT CONSIST OF?

It is a double competition; the amateur one among young university and vocational students; and professional between teams of national and international Security Forces and Bodies.

On the one hand, in the amateur competition the participants will have to face a challenge of a multidisciplinary nature (technical, legal, and communicative), thus having to demonstrate their skills and abilities in the matter.

On the other hand, in the professional competition the participants will have to face a purely technical challenge, according to the expert level of the Security Forces and Bodies in cybersecurity.



III NATIONAL LEAGUE OF CHALLENGES IN CYBERSPACE ~ NATIONAL CYBERLEAGUE

> AMATEUR COMPETITION

> HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE?

It is essential to be between 18 and 26 years (before the end of this 2021). You must take or have completed a University Degree or Professional Training studies (Higher Degree or specialization courses), being able to participate individually or in teams.

The specific requirements for participation will be detailed in the participation rules.

> STAGES OF THE COMPETITION

The competition will have THREE differentiated stages (subject to confirmation of the exact date):

1st QUALIFYING STAGE, end of October 2021.

2nd SEMI-FINAL STAGE, beginning of December 2021.

3rd FINAL STAGE, mid-December 2021.

The qualifying and semi-final stages will be online and will be held through a virtual platform, which will allow to recreate with total similarity, a real scenario where the participant, in addition to proceeding with the development of the challenge, may also attend a multitude of related activities with cybersecurity.

Regarding the final stage, if the socio-sanitary circumstances allow it, it will be held onsite at the headquarters of the Centro Universitario de la Guardia Civil in Aranjuez (Madrid)



> PROFESSIONAL COMPETITION

> HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE?

This competition is focused on members of the Security Forces and Bodies, as well as agencies and other national and international bodies, with competencies in cybersecurity. All this, under the criteria of selection of the organization.

> STAGES OF THE COMPETITION

In contrast to the amateur competition, the professional competition will consist of a single FINAL STAGE, which will match the dates (mid-December 2021) and place (CUGC, Aranjuez) with the final stage of the amateur competition.

As in the amateur competition, the onsite meeting shall remain subject to socio-sanitary circumstances and must be held online otherwise.
